

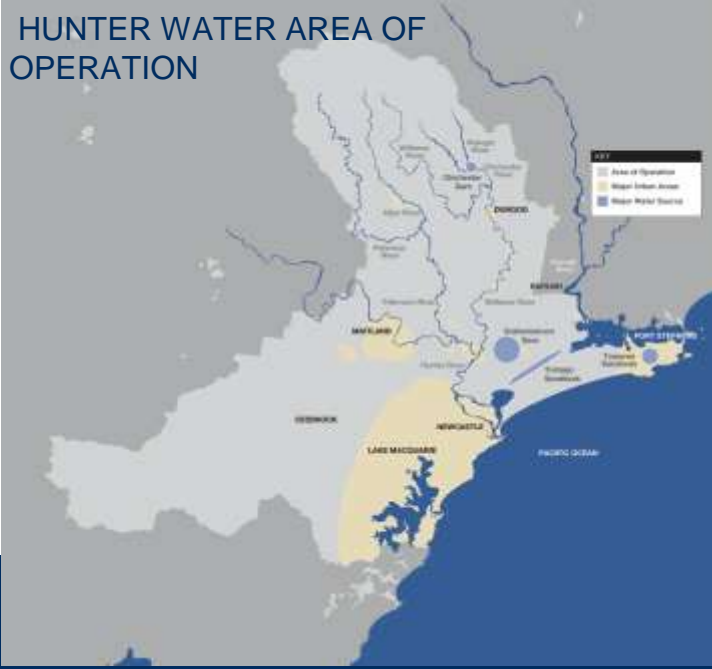

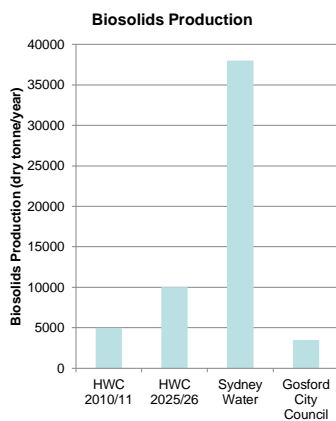
KEY RISKS AND OPPORTUNITIES

Stratford residents protest - caught in the middle

'Caught in the middle' is how Stratford residents have described their plight at a public meeting last week.

The meeting at Stratford Hall last Tuesday brought together around 55 people concerned about the impact of the Stratford coal mine, the proposed Lucas gas pipeline and smelting coming from the use of biosolids as a fertilizer on a Stratford district property.

Stratford shop proprietor Marie Adams told the meeting how at 10 o'clock she had to keep the doors and windows to the shop closed and couldn't see the exhaust fans because of the foyl odours.

"We should not have to put up with it," she said.

"The smell is absolutely disgusting."

Farmers Lane resident Gary Ferns also addressed the meeting and said while he is some five to six kilometers "up the covey flock" from Stratford the smell from the biosolids is just as bad.
